iDNA test

A £1.3m project has been completed in Grimsby at the Bradley Road sports facilities, which included the implementation of the first iDNA football pitch by Desso Sports Systems.

Installed by Agripower Contractors, the new site features an irrigated, floodlit full size natural Premier pitch with seating, a full size Desso iDNA floodlit 3G synthetic pitch to both Football Association and Football Foundation specifications, three full size natural training pitches, which have been drained and sand ameliorated, attenuation for the pavillion, car parks and all pitch works, site secure fencing systems for the area, turnstiles and stands. The new facilities upgrade the previously used single

playing field with derelict old changing rooms, which were boarded up.

The decision to install Desso's iDNA pitch was made as the facilities management team wanted a surface to play football on throughout the year and able to withstand heavy use so that training and matches could be played in the same place under the same conditions.

The Bradley Road project was part-funded by North East Lincolnshire Council, the Football Association and the Football Foundation.
